

The Department of Economics at the Center for Research and Teaching in Economics (CIDE) seeks applications to fill three tenure-track positions (in econometrics, macroeconomics and applied microeconomics) at its Mexico City campus, and one limited term visiting assistant professor position (in environmental economics) at its Aguascalientes campus starting August 2022. Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in economics or related fields by August 2022.

The Department offers undergraduate and MSc programs in economics, and an MSc program in environmental economics (at the Aguascalientes campus).

Candidates are expected to provide evidence of potential to develop an outstanding record of scholarly research and quality teaching. Expected teaching load is two courses per year. The knowledge of Spanish is not required. However, we expect successful applicants to teach in Spanish within two years following the appointment.

CIDE has a strong institutional commitment to diversity and inclusion. Women and members of all underrepresented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.

Candidates must include in their cover letter a brief statement of why they are interested in joining the faculty at CIDE, otherwise the application will not be considered.
